This booklet walks the candidate through each step of the trail from Life to Eagle and will be like a bright flashlight to help our Scouts know where to go and avoid the difficulties along the way. Adams National Eagle Scout Project of the Year Award – Each of our Eagle Scouts from the Class of 2010 was eligible to submit his project to our local council's National Eagle Scout Association Committee for consideration. The winner at the Council level will be awarded a framed certificate and a bronze device for his Eagle Scout Square Knot. The three Regional winners who do not win the national award will receive a framed certificate and a gold device and \$500 to pay for future educational expenses. The local council will also receive \$100. The national winner will receive a plaque and a silver device for the Eagle square knot and a cash award of \$2500. His council also receives \$2500. Additional information about the Adams Award and the application is available at www.NESA.org. Last year's winner was Alex Griffith's service project – a playground built at a children's hospital in Krasnoyarsk, Russia. This is an annual award and applications will be due around January 15th each year. Three of last year's Indian River District Eagles stated that they were going to submit their project last month.
