

Troop 567 Financial Policies

Our troop leadership has always been eager to ensure that no scout misses an opportunity because of financial concerns.

Summer Camp

Scouts – as outlined in our "Putting on the Green Loops" guide for parents (see our web site www.troop567.org), financial assistance is available to help defray the cost of summer camp if needed. To qualify for consideration the scout must have participated in our major fund-raising activities (popcorn and camp cards). Further, requests must be submitted by April 15th.

Scouts can earn free summer camp by selling a minimum number of camp cards. The required total will vary depending upon the cost of camp for a given year and the level of reimbursement. The required minimum will be determined and announced to the troop each year at the commencement of the camp card sales.

Transportation costs are in addition to summer camp tuition.

Other Activities

Scouts will receive credit for sale of camp cards and their balances recorded by the troop treasurer. The actual credit per card will vary from year to year depending on council policy. Credit can be applied to most reasonable scouting expenses such as dues, campouts, scout shop purchases, and high adventure activities.

Requests for Assistance

Parents who may need financial assistance in order that their boys can participate in troop activities are strongly encouraged to approach a member of the Troop Committee or Adult Leader of the troop to discuss available resources.
